Summer Camp 2026 Frequently Asked Questions

Program & Participation

Q: Can I purchase separate weeks?

A: No. Our program is designed as a full 6-week experience to support continuity and build toward a final project.

Q: Can we pay for six weeks and take time off?

A: Not advised. The program builds toward a final project, so full participation is strongly encouraged for the best experience.

Q: What if my child is about to turn 5?

A: We cannot accept children who have not completed Kindergarten.

Q: Does this camp provide care for younger children?

A: Unfortunately, no. Our program is for K-8 students only.

Q: Is there additional morning or afternoon care I can purchase?

A: No. The tuition is set at **\$1,500**, and camp hours are **8:30 am-4:30 pm**, which includes **30 minutes of morning care and 30 minutes of afternoon care**.

Meals & Supplies

Q: Can I bring my own lunch?

A: Yes. Families may send a packed lunch for their child if preferred.

Q: What do I do if my child loses his camp-provided hat or t-shirt?

A: No worries! We have additional hats and t-shirts available for purchase.

Safety & Forms

Q: Can I join the camp without a medical form?

A: No. A completed medical form is required for every camper to ensure safety and compliance with state regulations.

Pricing & Discounts

Q: Is there a sibling discount?

A: No. In order to keep tuition as low as possible for all families, we do not offer sibling discounts.

Field Trips & Parent Participation

Q: Can I chaperone field trips?

A: Yes. Parents are welcome to chaperone, but you must travel independently and cover your own ticket costs.

Q: If I go on a field trip, can I take my child home with me?

A: Yes, with a **written note** provided in advance giving permission.

Technology & Personal Items

Q: Can I send my child with a cell phone?

A: Yes, but it must be **on vibrate** and used according to our **cell phone and technology guidelines** in the parent handbook.
